At 12 pm SHV&F-LP will be holding a Well-Being group for HM Veterans; and supported by Anne Walker - Health & Wellbeing support from Worker Walking With The Wounded (WWTW).

This month will be a relaxation session, that will involve the reading of a guided imagery script, as well as practicing - breathing and progressive muscle relaxation techniques. For some of the benefits of relaxation please see below.



The benefits of using a relaxation technique are overwhelming. Regular practice of relaxation techniques could assist you in relieving muscle tension, reduce anxiety, and improve your overall wellbeing. Other physiological benefits include:

- Decrease in heart rate
- Decrease in respiration rate
- Decrease in blood pressure
- Decrease in muscle tension
- Decrease in metabolic rate and oxygen consumption

Daily, practicing relaxation exercises 20–30 minutes, can produce, over time, a general feeling of relaxation and increased wellbeing that benefits every area of your life. When you feel relaxed and at ease, you feel more in control which leads to calm, realistic responses.

Throughout the morning, you can meet with representatives from Veterans UK, SSAFA, Combat Stress, Citizens Advice (CA), Walking with the Wounded (WWTW), SERVES, Vulnerable Veterans, The Warrior Programme, The Royal British Legion will be available.


